The computer lab is open before and after school during the hours listed above. Students must sign in on the clipboard each time they use the computer lab before or after school. Computers can be used to do research needed for class projects/papers and for using the programs listed below.

Study Island

Study Island is a web based program that allows kids to practice topics that prepare them for the MCA state standardized tests that all students are required to take. Study Island is available to all students 5th and up. Each student has a username and password to log into their individual program and because it is web based students can use the program anywhere they have access to the internet.

Students can choose their desired study mode, either fun interactive games or a standard test format. Study Island helps students build their skills, which helps build their confidence during testing time.

Incentive- Each time a student masters a subject level by receiving all blue ribbons for that subject they will earn a \$2.00 Bear Wear certificate!

Read Naturally

Read Naturally is a computer based software program that improves students reading fluency while increasing their comprehension. The stories are fun and interesting for students which help motivate them to reach their reading goals.

Incentive - Students who participate in the Read Naturally program will receive a \$3.00 Bear Wear certificate each time they increase their reading level!

Tutoring/Homework Help- Media Center (Library)

Certified Teachers are available to assist students as needed. The C-G School encourages all students who would like to sharpen their skills or might be struggling with a particular subject to take advantage of this opportunity.

Bears That Care

All students who participate in the Program will receive a **FREE Bears That Care T-Shirt!**

This is a fun and rewarding opportunity for students 5th and up to be involved in a community service program driven by the Youth and benefits our school and our communities. Some activities included in this program are the **inkjet cartridge/cell phone recycling project**, doing activities with residence at the **Good Samaritan Center** and **Adopt-a-Highway** program. Other projects and opportunities for the Bears That Care students arise throughout the year. Bears That Care will meet once a week after school (**day to be determined**) and depending on the project, meeting times could be more than once per week. As a reward for participation, pizza parties will be scheduled accordingly.

Youth Connection at the Clear Waters Life Center

After school until 5:30

4 - 6th grade – Tuesdays

7- 12th grade – Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays

Buses to the drop-off points will pick up at the Life Center at 5:00. Child must be picked up at the drop-off points. Approximate arrival times are Leonard 5:15, Red Lake 5:30, Gonvick 5:05.

Elementary students need to let their classroom teacher know if they will be using the transportation from the Life Center on Tuesdays to one of the drop-off points. This will help us provide the appropriate vehicle needed (bus or van) for the number of students riding.

The Clear Waters Life Center offers a safe and fun after school program that includes food and beverages, arts and crafts projects and a variety of physical activities in the gymnasium. Students can ride bus #7 from the school to the CWLC. A separate transportation permission slip was given to 4th-6th grade students.

A sign-up sheet will be located next to Rhoda Bergs'/Counselors office where Junior/High School students need to indicate by Noon each day if they are staying after school to participate in any one of the programs provided. This information is needed to know how many Teachers/Staff need to be present and to provide sufficient transportation for students. If your child is staying to participate in the after school programs and does not sign up, a Teacher might not be available to work with them. A bus or van is provided for transportation depending on the number of students signed up. If they didn't sign up there might not be any room on the bus or van for them.
